ITN

Innovative Training Networks

What does it offer?

High-quality research training delivered through international and interdisciplinary networks, industrial doctorates or joint doctorates

Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral level (less than four years of full-time research experience and no doctoral degree)



IF

Individual Fellowships

What does it offer?

Opportunities to work on personal research projects by moving between countries and possibly sectors to acquire new skills

Who applies?

Individual researchers together with the host organisation

Who is funded?

Postdoctoral researchers



RISE

Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

What does it offer?

The exchange of staff members involved in research and innovation to develop sustainable collaborative projects and the transfer of knowledge

Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

Who is funded?

Researchers, technical, administrative and managerial staff of any nationality and at all career levels



COFUND

Co-Funding of Regional, National and International Programmes

What does it offer?

Regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development

Who applies?

Organisations funding or managing doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes

Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral and postdoctoral level

Associated Country(AC): Iceland, Norway, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, <u>Turkey</u>, Israel, Moldova, Switzerland, Faroe Islands, Ukraine, Tunisia, Georgia, Armenia

Third Country (TC): any other country (n.b. Annex A list of countries that can receive funding)

Academic sector

- Higher education establishments (awarding academic degrees)
- Non-profit research organisations (primary mission research)
- International European interest organisations (e.g. CERN, EMBL)



Non-academic sector

- Any entity not included in the academic sector:
- e.g. large companies, SMEs, NGOs, museums, hospitals, international organisations (e.g. UN, WHO)


ITN Innovative Training Networks

Objective:

- To train a new generation of creative, entrepreneurial and innovative early-stage researchers
- To raise excellence and structure research and doctoral training
- To provide enhanced career perspectives in both the academic and non-academic sectors

Features:


- Only for early stage researchers
- Fellowships of 3-36 months
- Project duration up to 4 years
- Maximum 540 researcher-months





Key features ITN

- Training of next generation early stage researchers (ESR)
- Any scientific domain
- International, multidisciplinary, inter-sectoral networks of organisations
- Recruitment (EURAXESS portal for vacancies)
- Secondments possible & encouraged

Participants implement a joint research & training programme

EID

European Industrial Doctorates

Doctoral training with the non-academic sector

Each researcher - enrolled in a doctoral programme and spend at least 50% in the non-academic sector.

The joint supervision of fellows by supervisors from each sector is mandatory.

EJD

European Joint Doctorates

Doctoral programme to deliver joint degrees

Creation of joint doctoral programmes, leading to the delivery of joint, double or multiple doctoral degrees

RISE

Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

Objective:

- To strengthen the interaction between academic and non-academic organisations, and between Europe and third countries
- Research projects implemented through research and innovation staff exchanges
- International and inter-sector transfer of knowledge and sharing of ideas and of R&I culture

Features:

- Staff members eligibility condition: at least 1 month at the sending institution prior to first secondment
- Secondments from 1 to 12 months per person
- Consortium > three independent organisations from three different countries (two of which in MS/AC)
- Project duration up to 4 years
- Maximum 540 researcher-months



Key features RISE



- Consortium vision for a joint Research and Innovation project via staff exchanges (secondments)
- Any scientific domain
- All types of staff (ER, ESR, managers, technical, administrative)
- International and intersectoral exchanges (n.b. organisations can send and/or receive staff)



COFUND

Objective:

 To stimulate regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development, by co-funding new or existing regional, national, and international programmes.

Features:

- Mono-beneficiary: organisation funding or managing doctoral or post-doctoral programmes
- Duration of projects: between 3 and 5 years
- Duration of fellowships: minimum 3 months





Key features COFUND



Cofunding of research programmes

- COFUND provides funding for funders
- Stimulates regional, national or international programmes
- At all stages of their career (ESR, ER)
- For doctoral programmes and fellowship programmes



COFUND



- Leverage funding and combat fragmentation (possible synergies with ESIF)
- EU contribution to cover living allowances for researchers and management costs limited to 10 M€ per beneficiary per call
- 50% co-funding for established unit costs
- Minimum living allowance fixed in the WP






