



VIEW/EDIT PARTNER SEARCH

LEARs, Account Administrators or self-registrants can publish partner requests for open and forthcoming topics after logging into the Participant Portal.

Organisations can launch a request for partners related to the specific call on the call page





#### Submission of proposal

- Submission via the Research & Innovation Participant Portal (electronic submission only)
- Registered user: Submit proposals, sign grant agreements, manage lifecycle etc.
- Very important: Start preparing the proposal as early as possible and submit on time

#### Admissibility & eligibility check SCC (1)

Minimum

2 lighthouse

& 5 follower

cities

Proposal max. **150 pages** 

A lighthouse city can be funded only once under H2020

Check General Annexes of the Work Programme for all eligibility and admissibility criteria

#### Admissibility & eligibility check SCC (2)

#### **Attention! Applies to lighthouse cities**

Sustainable Energy Action Plans (SEAP) Sustainable
Energy and
Climate Action
Plan (SECAP)

A similar equally ambitious plan

One of these plans MUST be validated by the Joint Research Centre (JRC)







# **2**<sub>4</sub>

#### Admissibility & eligibility check ES1

ES1 subtopic 2: Cooperation with Canada

Proposals must include a final draft of **coordination agreement** with Canadian funding authority

Art. 2, Art. 41.5 and Art. 50.3.1 of the model Grant Agreement will apply

Check General Annexes of the Work Programme for all eligibility and admissibility criteria







#### Admissibility & eligibility check ES6 and ES8

#### ES6 subtopic 4

Proposals shall include
min. 1 participant from
a non-EU/associated country
member of the Mission Innovation

#### ES8

Grant condition: proposals should provide **support to third parties** in the form of lump sum grants. Article 15.1 and 15.3 of the model grant agreement will apply

Check General Annexes of the Work Programme for all eligibility and admissibility criteria







#### **Evaluation by external experts**

#### EU database of over 80,000 evaluators

- 1. High-level expertise
- 2. Independence
- 3. Impartiality

**Balanced composition** 

**Regular rotation & new experts** 

Not applying? Become an evaluator!





#### **Evaluation process**

Min. 3 experts per call

Proposals evaluated as submitted

Lower score if shortcomings are identified

Rejecting proposal if weaknesses are identified



#### What do the experts do?

**Understand the call** 

**Evaluate individually - remotely** 

Meet to reach consensus



### Against what do they evaluate?

1. Excellence

2. Impact

3. Quality and efficiency





#### **Outcome of evaluation**

Ranked list of proposals

**Main list** 



Reserve list

???

Rejection



**Deadline to inform: 5 months** 





#### **Grant agreement**

Successful proposals are invited to start a Grant Agreement Preparation

Very tight deadline: max. 8 months

No negotiation phase = no substantial changes



#### Conclusions

- Evaluation: a transparent, fair and efficient process
- Large demand and strong competition
- Pencil the opening dates and deadlines in your calendars
- Start preparing your proposals as early as possible
- Check FAQs on the Participant Portal
- Don't wait until the deadline to submit your proposal
- And if you are not submitting proposals, become an evaluator!
