It is the responsibility of the applicant to verify that the submitted pdf documents are readable and are within the page limit.
- The minimum font size:11 points. Standard character spacing, minimum of single line spacing. The page size is A4. All margins; min 15 mm (not including any footers or headers). Times New Roman.

- Each proposal is read and evaluated by **three evaluators** in an individual and independent manner. Each evaluator prepares an *individual evaluation report*.
- The three evaluators discuss together to reach a **unanimous consensus** on the final comments and score, and prepare a *consensus report*, containing relevant elements from the three individual reports.
- The consensus score determines the position on the ranking list.
- Applicants receive their *evaluation summary report* (i.e. a copy of the consensus report) in January.

0 – Proposal fails to address the criterion and cannot be assessed due to missing or incomplete information.

1 – Poor. The criterion is inadequately addressed, or there are serious inherent weaknesses.

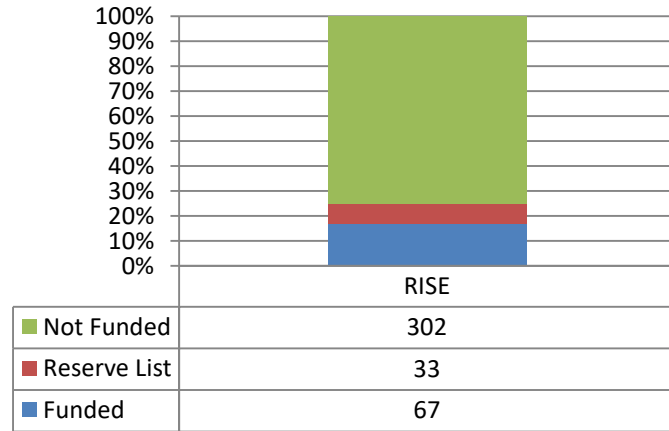

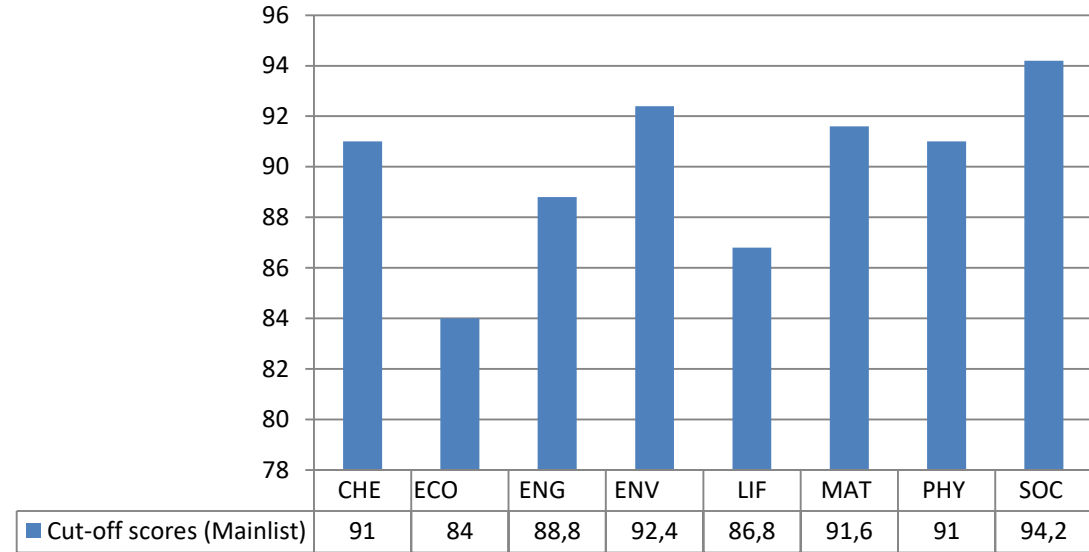
