PF: Can periods of inactivity due to the pandemic of COVID-19 and prolonged strikes at a university be considered and deducted as career breaks?

This has to be properly documented, just a statement is not sufficient. There needs to be proof that the organisation was shut down and the employees were suspended during the pandemic and strikes. In particular, the exemption for the period of university closures due to COVID can only be applied if the fellow was not under contract with the university during that time. If the fellow continued to be paid, that period must be counted as research time. Ultimately, it is up to the hosting organisation to verify the eligibility of the fellow.

Regardless of your nationality, whether you are a Master's or PhD student, or in an advanced stage of your career, EURAXESS can help unlock your potential in Europe.

The benefits of a researcher's residence permit in an EU country

1. A researcher's residence permit will give you the same rights as a national of your host country in terms of pay and working conditions, access to goods and services, recognition of professional qualifications and social security.
2. A residence permit will be granted to your family members for the duration of your own permit, if the conditions are fulfilled.
3. You can take up a teaching position. Member States may set a maximum number of hours or of days for the activity of teaching.



Can a researcher move to another European country?

Once granted the residence permit or long-stay visa, a researcher may carry out their research not only in the country of their residence permit/long-stay visa, but also in other EU Member States under specific conditions.

The procedure to follow depends on the country where the researcher will go and the duration of stay:

A researcher wishing to carry out a part of their research in another EU Member State for up to 6 months may need to send a number of documents to the authorities of that Member State and is then allowed to move there immediately after.

A researcher wishing to carry out a part of their research in another Member State for more than 6 months will need to follow, depending on the Member State concerned, either the same procedure as for a stay shorter than 6 months, or will need to apply for a "long-term mobility" permit in that Member State.

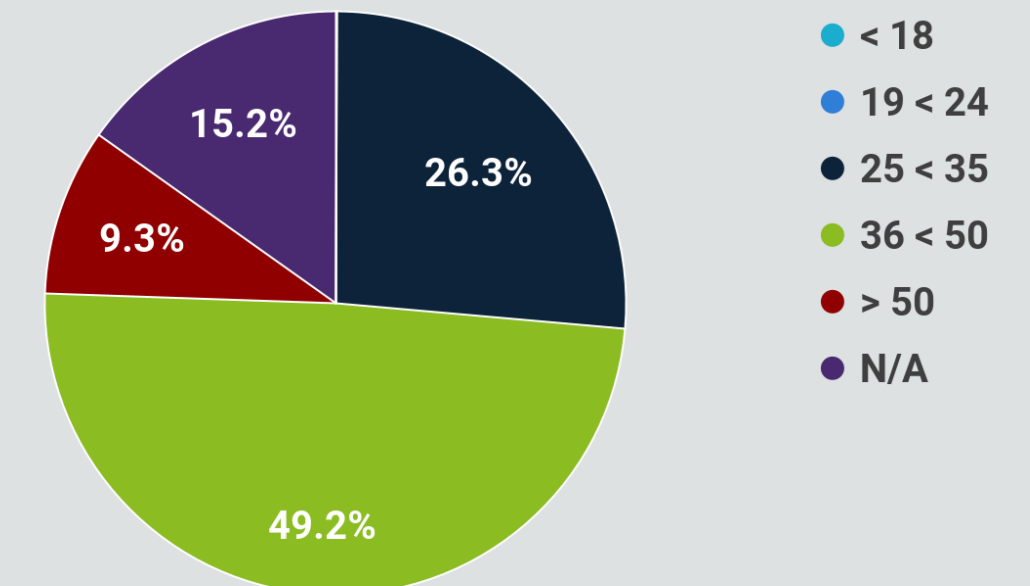
